Outline of International Exchange Subjects Provided by Japanese Language and Culture Course, Osaka University Short-Term Student Exchange Program (Maple)

Students who want to take International Exchange Subjects provided by the Japanese Language and Culture Course, Osaka University Short-Term Student Exchange Program ("Maple") in 2019 Spring and Summer Terms is required to follow the application procedures described below.

- 1. Japanese language subjects and lecture / seminar subjects in Japanese
- (1) Eligible students: International students of undergraduate and graduate schools (regular students)/ exchange students (special auditing students)
- (2) Enrollment procedures:
  - ① Students who want to take the subjects shall take a placement test held by Center for Japanese Language and Culture Education ("CJLC") to assess their individual Japanese proficiency level. However, students who have been evaluated "C1 level" in CJLC within a year will be exempted from the exam.
  - ② Students who want to take the subjects shall choose from the subjects which based on each judged level, fill out the Registration Form (Download it from CJLC website.) and shall submit to the CJLC Office (1st floor in CJLC building).
- (3) Procedure period:
  - $\odot$  Date of placement test: March 4(MON) to March 22(FRI), 2019 (\*)
  - ② Subject Registration: April 4(THU) to 22(MON), 2019
  - 3 Subject registration confirmation: May 7(TUE) to 13(MON), 2019
    - (\*) About Placement test
      - The Placement Test will be conducted on the internet and e-mail. For more information about the test system, refer to the CJLC website. (Details will be posted in the early of March.)
- (4) Enrollment limit: Classes may not be available even though after submitting the registration form. It will be informed until April 24(WED).

(2) Enrollment procedures: Students shall choose subjects they want to take

of KOAN.

However, students also can register subjects by submitting the Registration

Form (Download it from CJLC's website and complete) to the CJLC office.

(3) Registration period: The Registration Form shall be submitted from

April 4(THU) to April 22(MON), 2019.

(4) Enrollment limit: Classes may not be available in some subjects.
