

## **Outline of International Exchange Subjects Provided by Japanese Language and Culture Course, Osaka University Short-Term Student Exchange Program (Maple)**

Students who want to take International Exchange Subjects provided by the Japanese Language and Culture Course, Osaka University Short-Term Student Exchange Program ("Maple") in 2021 Fall and Winter Semester is required to follow the application procedures described below.

### 1. Japanese language subjects and lecture / seminar subjects in Japanese

- (1) Eligible students: International students of undergraduate and graduate schools (regular students)/ exchange students (special auditing students)
- (2) Enrollment procedures:
  - ① Students who want to take the subjects shall take a placement test held by Center for Japanese Language and Culture ("CJLC") to assess their individual Japanese proficiency level. However, students who have been evaluated "C1 level" in CJLC within a year will be exempted from the exam.
  - ② Students who want to take the subjects shall choose from the subjects which based on each judged level, fill out the Registration Form (Download it from CJLC website.) and shall submit to the CJLC Office (7<sup>th</sup> floor in Research and Education Hub (741).
- (3) Procedure period:
  - ① Date of placement test: August 30 (MON) to September 5 (SUN), 2021 (\*)
  - ② Subject Registration: September 6 (MON) to 20 (MON), 2021
  - ③ Subject registration confirmation: October 8 (FRI) to 21 (THU), 2021

(\*) About Placement test

The Placement Test will be conducted on the internet and e-mail. For more information about the test system, refer to the CJLC website. (Details will be posted in the middle of August.)
- (4) Registration restriction: The maximum number of courses that can be taken is 3, You may include "Lecture/Seminar Subject" which is offered in English in that. You can report maximum five subjects you wish to take in order of preference.

In case there are some subjects that you cannot take in the top three classes you wish, you will be notified about this by October 7 (THU.).

## 2. Lecture / seminar subjects in English

- (1) Eligible students: Students of undergraduate and graduate schools (regular students)/ exchange students (special auditing students)
- (2) Enrollment procedures: Students who want to take the subjects shall choose from the subjects list, fill out the Registration Form (Download it from CJLC website.) and shall submit to the CJLC Office (7th floor in Research and Education Hub, (741)).
- (3) Registration period: The Registration Form shall be submitted from September 6(MON) to 20(MON), 2021.
- (4) Registration restriction: The maximum number of courses that can be taken is 3. You can report maximum five subjects you wish to take in order of preference. In case there are some subjects that you cannot take in the top three classes you wish, you will be notified about this by October 7 (THU.).
